# WHAT IS THE INVISION KIDS PROGRAM?

Invision has budgeted	each year to pay for eye exams and glasses. The project funds are
donated and managed by Drs	, the optometrists of Invision.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any student in grades K-12 in Montgomery County, Radford City, Salem City and Glenvar schools. This program is aimed at kids without vision insurance whose families cannot afforded glasses.

# **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

Very simply, eligibility is at the sole discretion of teachers, counselors, administrators or school nurses. There is no criteria or paperwork used to determine need. If need is seen, a designated school nurse will be the liaison to the nearest Invision location in Christiansburg or Salem. The nurse will fill out and fax or email the attached form to our office to get the process started. Our Staff will then contact the school nurse or parent to schedule, as noted on the form.

### ARE THERE ANY OBLIGATIONS OR "STRINGS ATTACHED?"

No. The program speaks for itself.

### WHY IS INVISION DOING THIS?

- As local eye doctors for over 20 years, we have seen many families who can't afford eye exams and glasses for their children but may not qualify for assistance programs.
- Educators recognize that good vision is essential to learning. Invision has been providing this service for years on an informal basis; we want to make sure that our local educators are aware of it
- Invision supports educators and kids in our local communities. Our doctors and staff want to show care for our neighbors.
- Invision is not doing this for public recognition. We prefer to do this under the radar through a trusted network of teachers, nurses and administrators.
